Disclosure: Dues payments to the Louisiana Psychological Association are not tax deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. However, membership dues may be deductible as an ordinary and necessary business expense, subject to exclusion for lobbying activity. It is estimated that 5% of your LPA dues will be allocated for lobbying expenditures for 2017-2018 and so not tax deductible.

MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

Full Member: Full members are (1) person holding a doctoral degree in psychology conferred by a regionally accredited college, university or professional school of psychology, or program of equivalent standing outside of the U.S. or (2) a person holding an active Louisiana psychology license.

New Full Member (first year applying): Same membership requirements as full members. (All full members are eligible to vote and hold office).

Associate Member: Associate members are individuals who have earned a Master's degree in psychology from a regionally accredited graduate school. (Associates are not eligible to vote or hold office).

Academic/Scientific Member: This category of membership is reserved for doctoral level psychologists who are primarily involved in research in academic / university-affiliated settings. (Members are eligible to vote).

Life Member: This category of membership is available to 1) Psychologists who are 70 or older, who must have been LPA members for 10 consecutive years and who have officially discontinued their psychological workload/income or (2) Psychologists who are 65 or older, who have been LPA members for 10 consecutive years and who have reduced their psychological workload/income by 75% or more.

Student Member: Student members are individuals currently enrolled in a graduate or undergraduate psychology program or a regionally accredited psychology program of study. (Student members are not eligible to vote or hold office).
